



# NEWC Packing List

Label everything! Many similar items are brought to camp which makes it difficult to sort personal belongings at the end of the week. Please make sure to label all items with your teen's name, using a label or permanent marker. Any items left at camp are held for 30 days then donated to the local support shop. Expect your teen to return home needing to do laundry.

## Clothing

- One outfit to get wet/dirty in. There will be games/activities in the evening, some involving water. Please bring these clothes to camp each day in preparation for this.
- Shirts
- Shorts and pants
- Pajamas
- Socks and underwear
- Light sweatshirt or jacket (indoors with A/C can become chilly)
- Swimsuit (girls: one piece or tankini with dark T-shirt to cover stomach)
- Sneakers and casual shoes

## Personal Items

- Toiletries: shampoo, body wash, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.
- 2 towels (1 for shower and 1 for activities)
- Sleeping bag
- Personal medication, including prescription and over the counter. Please note: all over the counter medications are held by the camp nurse. All medication must be in original packaging and properly labeled.
- Pillow

## Camp Gear

- Water bottle
- Bible, pens, and notebook
- Battery operated alarm clock
- Cash for canteen (T-shirts, snacks, and drinks will be available for purchase)

## For worship team times:

- Instrument (keyboard and drum set provided)
- Drummers need to bring drum sticks
- Ear buds to be used with in ear monitors

## Additional Information

### What to Leave at Home

Do not bring: hair dye, fireworks, firearms, piercing supplies, MP3 players, portable game players, iPods, iPads, Kindles, laptops, or any other entertainment device.

### Unplugged Policy

We have an "unplugged" policy at NEWC. Counselors hold camper cell phones and will make phones available during designated down time when campers may call home. If a phone is found on a camper during a non-designated time, it will immediately be turned in to the campers' counselor and held until the end of the day.
